

Long Description:

Day 1: CUSCO – AGUAS CALIENTES

The adventure starts early, with pickup of our passengers between 6:00 AM and 7:00 AM from their respective hotels. From Cusco, the transport to Hidroeléctrica begins, a journey of approximately 6 hours that crosses the breathtaking landscapes of the Sacred Valley. During the journey, a stop is made in Santa Teresa, where you will enjoy lunch at a local restaurant, perfect for recharging your batteries.

The journey continues to the Santa Teresa Valley, where we will finally reach the Hidroeléctrica station. From here, a leisurely 2.5-hour hike (mostly flat) begins to Aguas Calientes, the picturesque town at the foot of Machu Picchu. - If you prefer not to walk, there is the option of taking a train (depending on the option selected) that will comfortably take you to Aguas Calientes

Upon arrival in Aguas Calientes, the group will be greeted by a tour guide in the Plaza de Armas, who will provide details about the next day's tour and direct you to your accommodation (2★ or 3★, depending on option chosen). Take the opportunity to relax in the local hot springs, a revitalizing experience to end the day

In the evening, there will be a group dinner, during which the final information for the next day's exploration will be provided

Day 2: AGUAS CALIENTES – MACHU PICCHU – CUSCO

The second day starts early, with a delicious breakfast at the hotel. The idea is to get to Machu Picchu just as they open, to explore with few tourists around you.

There are two options for getting to the main entrance of Machu Picchu:

Option 1: Walking: If you decide to walk, you will start your journey at 4:00 AM from Aguas Calientes. The hike, which takes around 1 hour and 20 minutes, will take you along a challenging route, passing by almost 1,700 Inca steps. The goal is to arrive before the coaches so you can be among the first to enter the archaeological site. Once at the base, you'll arrive at the checkpoint and, after showing your admission ticket and passport, you'll begin the final climb to Machu Picchu.

Option 2: By coach (not included): If you prefer comfort, you can take the coach, which departs from Aguas Calientes at 5:30 am. The trip takes approximately

25 minutes, and upon arrival, you will enter the archeological site directly at 6:00 AM.

Once inside Machu Picchu, you'll have the opportunity to enjoy incredible panoramic views and take unforgettable photos. Next, you'll go on a 2-hour guided visit (only included for Tour 2; for other tours, choose the option with a private guide), where our expert will tell you the secrets of this amazing place. After the tour guide, you will have free time to explore the sanctuary at your own pace.

After your free time in Machu Picchu, the drop-off will be along the same path, walking back to Aguas Calientes, where you can enjoy lunch before continuing your trip to Cusco

Different options:

Basic Option

Includes accommodation in a 2★ hotel with local food, tour guide available only on Circuit 2, and hike from Hidroeléctrica to Aguas Calientes.

Option with Superior Hotel

Enjoy accommodation in a 3★ hotel and an enhanced dining experience

Option with Private Tour Guide in Machu Picchu

This option includes a tour guide on any assigned circuit: Circuit 1, 2, or 3 (up to 5 people).

Option with Train Included

Includes round-trip travel on a scenic train to enjoy the journey in complete comfort with spectacular views.

All-Inclusive Option (Recommended)

Enjoy a Complete Package that includes round-trip train travel, accommodation in a 3-star hotel, upgraded meals, and a private tour guide on any assigned circuit (1, 2, or 3).

Includes:

Round-trip transportation: from Cusco to Hidroeléctrica

Hike from Hidroeléctrica to Aguas Calientes: (except for the Train Included or All-Inclusive option).

Round-trip train transportation: from Ollantaytambo to Aguas Calientes (if the Train Included or All-Included option is selected).

Hike from Aguas Calientes to the citadel of Machu Picchu.

Accommodation: 1 night at a hostel in Aguas Calientes (2 or 3 ★ depending on the option selected when booking)

Meals: Lunch and dinner (Day 1) / Breakfast (Day 2)

Admission ticket to Machu Picchu

Professional tour guide in the Citadel for Circuit 2 (applies to any option)

Professional tour guide in the citadel for all Circuits: available only in the All-Inclusive option or in the option with a Private Guide in Machu Picchu

Not included:

Train ticket from Ollantaytambo to Aguas Calientes (except for the All-Inclusive or Train Included option)

Bus transportation from Aguas Calientes to the Machu Picchu Citadel

Optional extra visits: Huayna Picchu or Machu Picchu Mountain
