NEW OPERATION PROCEDURE



Blue Ice Skating Rink will limit the **maximum of 50 Skaters** inside the rink to control the crowd and to measure the safety of our visitor. Our tickets are now sold by session.

Timing of the Session (2 Hrs / Session)


^{*}Skaters may continue the session by purchasing a new ticket at the counter.

Security measures to prevent and reduce the possibility of Covid-19 deployment in the Blue Ice Skating Rink area.

- 1. Following the government's instructions to maintain a safe physical distance for each person, we will limit the *maximum of 50 skaters* inside the court at all times. Our ice skating rink is sized 12109 sq ft (1125m / approx 14 units of a badminton court).
- 2. All our operations (14 people for 2 shifts) are Malaysian. We will provide personal protective equipment (face masks, transparent face protection, gloves) for all our users. Each user's body temperature will be recorded 2 times daily.
- 3. We will not allow use without a mask. This includes students, coaches, skaters, and skating academy students.
- 4. We will study the body temperature for each person before entering our empathy. This includes students, coaches, skaters, and skating academy students. The problem is that people who are sick and have COVID-19 symptoms (fever, cough, watery, shortness of breath) will not make them use our premises.
- 5. We will provide a cleaner for everyone to wash their hands before taking our premises.
- 6. The information (name, phone number, time of arrival, body temperature) of each person entering our premises will be recorded by our staff daily.
- 7. Every working hour we will disinfect all of our public contact areas (seating, lockers, skates, hand-held) premises.
- 8. We are equipped with an emergency room to handle emergency case problems.
- 9. We will be constantly updating our preventive methods in accordance with our updated government guidelines.


NEW SAFETY MEASURES



*Skaters are required to wear gloves and socks before entering the ice area.


BODY TEMPERATURE MEASUREMENT

SYMPTOMS / ILLNESS

SOCIAL DISTANCING


Social distancing in practice always
