Upgrade Tour in Chinese

***This is an add-on tour, conducted in Chinese.**

Tour Description

This upgraded tour seamlessly blends the highlights of both the "Captain's Tour" and the "Chief Engineer's Tour," offering visitors an unprecedented, in-depth experience of the Battleship Missouri (60 Minutes). Led by a Memorial Chinese docent, participants will venture into core areas typically off-limits to the public—from the mechanical heart of the power engines to the battleship's advanced technological hub—personally exploring the Main Battery Plotting Room and the Combat Engagement Center. Exclusive tour highlights include the Captain's Cabin, the Combat Engagement Center (CEC), Broadway, the Boiler Room, the Engine Room, the Main Battery Plotting Room, and the interior of Turret #1—with every step transporting you back to the glorious era of these ironclad warships. Whether you are a history buff, a military enthusiast, or an adventurous traveler, this tour offers a unique behind-the-scenes perspective, deeply revealing the operational mysteries of this legendary battleship and allowing you to witness firsthand how the Missouri left an indelible mark on history.

For your safety, please note that this is a physically strenuous tour and is not recommended for those with mobility constraints. You must be able to climb several sets of "ladders," (Navy-talk for steep, narrow stairs), step over many two-foot-high obstacles, and navigate through tight doorways and low overheads. Closed-toe shoes are recommended, and this tour is limited to guests ages 10 and above. This intimate tour has a capacity of ten visitors at a time and runs approximately 60 minutes.

Tour Information

- This tour is conducted in Mandarin Chinese only.
- Maximum of ten visitors at a time.
- WITH PRE-PURCHASED TICKET printed or on mobile device: Enter the Pearl Harbor National Memorial (USS Arizona Memorial) and proceed to board the motor coach shuttle, located in front of the Pacific Fleet Submarine Museum, for transfer over Ford Island Bridge to the Missouri Pier. Present ticket at scanner on the Missouri Pier.
- Battleship Missouri Memorial Hours: Daily 8:00 am to 4:00 pm.
- Battleship Store Hours: Daily 8:00 am to 4:00 pm.
- Closed Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day.
- Security measures are in place at all Pearl Harbor attractions. Please advise your visitors not to bring bags of any size to the USS Missouri. Small cameras/camcorders, wallets, cell phones, water bottles, and medications are permissible.
