



**1 Harpa**  
The concert hall and conference centre is the latest landmark in Reykjavik and houses both the Iceland Symphony Orchestra and the Icelandic Opera.

**2 The Old Harbour**  
A colourful busy area with restaurants, shops and cafés. From here you can choose between different sailing tours.

**3 Reykjavik Maritime Museum**  
Explore the world of the Icelandic fisheries and coastal culture. The former coast guard vessel Óðinn is also docked there.

**4 Whales of Iceland**  
The biggest whale exhibition in the world! Life-sized models, an interactive installation and virtual reality experience. Fun for all ages

**FlyOver Iceland**  
Only two minutes walk away across the street from the stop you can find FlyOver Iceland. A very popular attraction which includes a breathtaking virtual ride over Iceland.

**Lava Show**  
The only live lava show in the world. Don't miss this unique opportunity to get up close to real molten lava, see it flowing, hear it sizzling, and feel the incredible heat that emanates from it.

**9 Hallgrímskirkja**  
The church spire is 73 m high, thus making this building the tallest one in Reykjavik city. The view from the tower is sublime.

**10 BSÍ Bus Terminal**  
Home of Reykjavik Excursions and the Flybus. From here you can join one of the many adventurous day tours heading outside the city or simply take the Flybus to Keflavik International airport.



**11 Perlan**  
A glass dome built on top of six hot water tanks. Inside you will find a restaurant, café and the amazing exhibition Wonders of Iceland. The 360° view from the observation deck is spectacular.



**12 Kringlan Shopping Mall**  
Iceland's first real shopping mall opened its doors in 1987 and includes today over 180 shops and restaurants along with a cinema and a public library. Next to the mall is the Reykjavik City Theatre.



**13 Hilton Nordica Reykjavik**  
A good start or end for guests staying in the larger hotels in this area; Grand Hotel, Reykjavik Lights, Hilton, and more. Many local companies, cafés and restaurants also reside in this area.

**14 Laugardalur Park**  
Laugardalur is a major centre for sports and recreation in the capital. In Laugardalur you will find Laugardalslaug, the city's largest swimming pool. You will also find a beautiful botanical garden and the Family Park and Zoo.

**15 Skarfabakki Harbour (Summer stop only)**  
From here you can take a boat tour over to Viðey island, stroll along the coastline to downtown Reykjavik or come inside and rent a vehicle for the day at Enterprise rent-a-car.

**16 Höfði House**  
Höfði is considered to be one of the most historically significant buildings in Reykjavik. It was the location for the 1986 summit meeting of president Ronald Reagan and the general secretary Mikhail Gorbachev, in order to end the Cold War.
