
FOR THE HEALTH & SAFETY OF OUR GUESTS

As an Austrian cable railway, Innsbruck's Nordkette Cable Railways are part of the public transport network. Therefore, the following Covid-19 regulations apply:



Wear a face mask

mandatory in all stations, funiculars & cable cars



Keep your distance

a minimum of 1 meter in the stations



Cough and sneeze properly



Wash your hands regulary with soap



Avoid touching your face

ADDITIONAL MEASURES

Hygiene facilities for our guests

All of our stations are equipped with **DISINFECTANT DISPENSERS** in the entrance areas of the railways. Furthermore, our bathroom facilities are equipped with sufficient wash basins, antibacterial soap, disinfectants and paper towels for thorough hand washing.

Trained staff

Our staff is well-trained in **SOCIAL DISTANCING** and knows how to greet guests appropriately. In addition, our staff is continuously updated and trained in the most current Covid-19 safety rules.

Rapid COVID-19 tests for staff

If there is a suspected case, our employees are instructed to stay away from work and are tested by means of a quick test in a private laboratory **WITHIN 2 – 3 HOURS.** All of our measures are continuously coordinated in cooperation with experts.

No queuing at the cashdesks

Please purchase your tickets in advance in the **ONLINE TICKET SHOP** TICKETS.NORDKETTE.COM to help us reduce contact points and avoid queues. This will also enable us to get in touch with you quickly and directly if necessary.

All online tickets (1–6 people) can be used directly at the turnstile and therefore do not have to be exchanged at the cash desk. Groups of 7 people or more receive a group ticket, which can be exchanged at our Pick-up Box (contactless and without waiting times) in the Congress station. There is also the option of cashless payments at all ticket counters. Our ticket machines also support contactless sales.

Reduced number of passengers

The number of passengers has been reduced: Hungerburg Funicular from 130 **to 60 people** Seegrube Cable Car from 95 **to 50 people** Hafelekar Cable Car from 69 **to 35 people**

Increase in departure frequency

If necessary, the departure frequency can be increased from every **15 MINUTES TO EVERY 10 MINUTES.** The cabins are permanently aired by opening the windows (while driving) and the doors (in the stations).

Regular and extensive disinfection

Regular cleaning and disinfection of frequently touched objects and surfaces such as handrails, handles, doorknobs etc. is carried out in the station buildings, funiculars, cable cars and restaurants.

Restaurant table reservation

For groups of 20 people or more, a reservation in advance is required and can be made at seegrube@don.at.
