1. What is the Museum of the Future?

- A new global scientific landmark from Dubai and the UAE to the world. A platform to study the future, design its ideas and create deep discussions about its trends in all scientific, development and humanitarian sectors.
- A permanent exhibition that showcases different aspects of the future as well as significant technologies from decades to come. It is a global intellectual centre that works closely with international partners and specialised research entities.
- It is an architectural icon and a significant addition to the world of science, architecture and art. The Museum of the Future was classified as one of the most creative buildings on Earth.

2. What is the message of the Museum of the Future?



- Leading the science and knowledge movement in the region, it will bring together 'Great Arab Minds' and direct their creativity and knowledge to shape a better future for humanity.
- Creating an intellectual movement, the museum explores and foresees future changes in the fields of science, human development, economics and many more.
- Connecting thinkers and experts from around the world through organizing continuous forums as well as highlighting the latest scientific changes and discoveries.
- The museum will embody humanity's contribution to the future. It will create experiences that will advance future communities and enhance people's lives.

3. How is the museum different to conventional museums?

“Living museum”

It represents active human imagination, creativity and innovation. Through forums and discussions, the museum aims to enhance human research, discoveries and findings.

“The most rejuvenated museum”

Its content and exhibits will constantly be renewed, enhanced and enriched with the latest technological achievements and global scientific discoveries.

“An incubator for global visionaries”

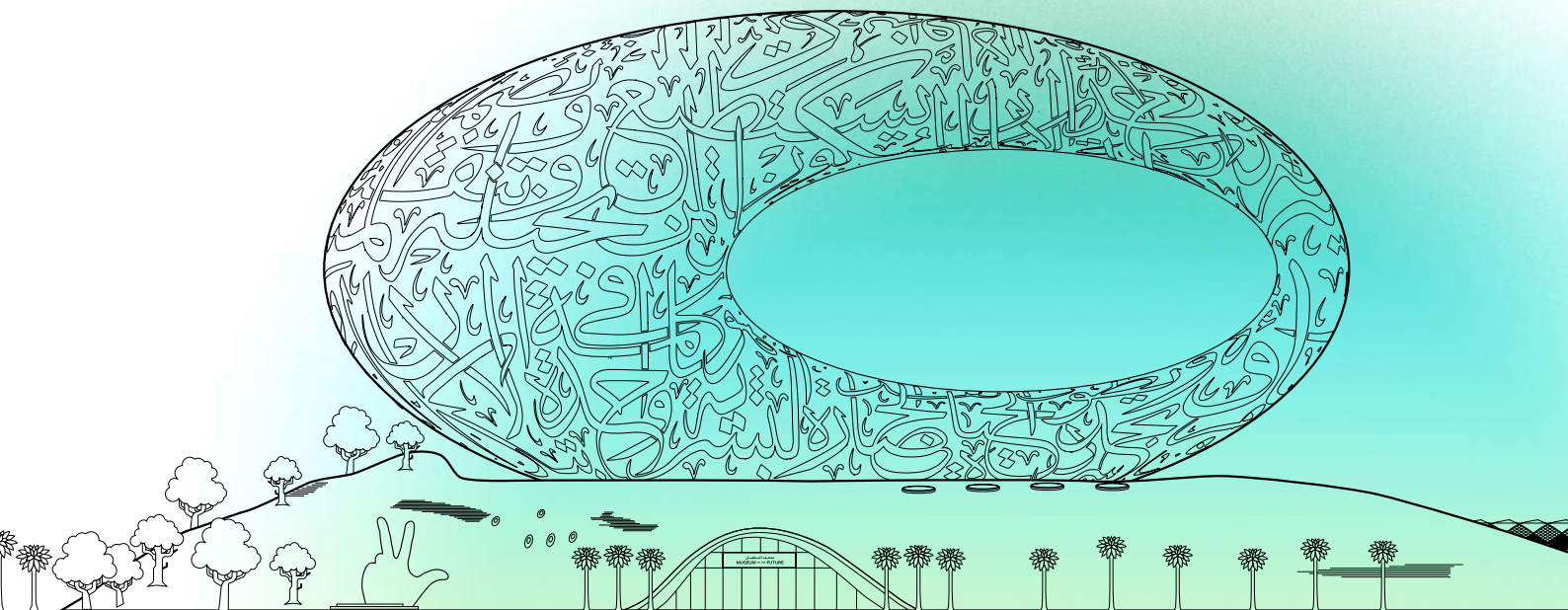
A hub for talents and geniuses at both regional and worldwide levels, the museum is also a comprehensive lab for future technologies, ideas and cities.



4. What is the architectural value of the Museum?

Architectural

- The museum is described as “the most beautiful building on Earth”. Reaching 77 metres in height, with seven floors inside and no internal pillars. The museum is an engineering miracle.
- The museum is a model of sustainability. The entire surface of the building is made of developed glass, manufactured with new technologies to improve the quality of the interior and exterior thermal isolation.
- The facade of the building extends over an area of 17,600 square metres. Made of stainless steel, the facade panels were produced using automated robotic arms.
- The museum’s design pays homage to digital technology, through the 1024 panels covering its facade. The specific number of panels represents a kilobyte: a basic unit of the digital information storage system of computers. Each kilobyte is equal to 1024 bytes, or 1024 symbols or characters.
- The facade of the museum is lighted by 14 thousand metres of programmable LED lighting. Made up of quotes written by HH Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, the Museum of the Future is the only building in the world that is entirely covered with Arabic calligraphy.



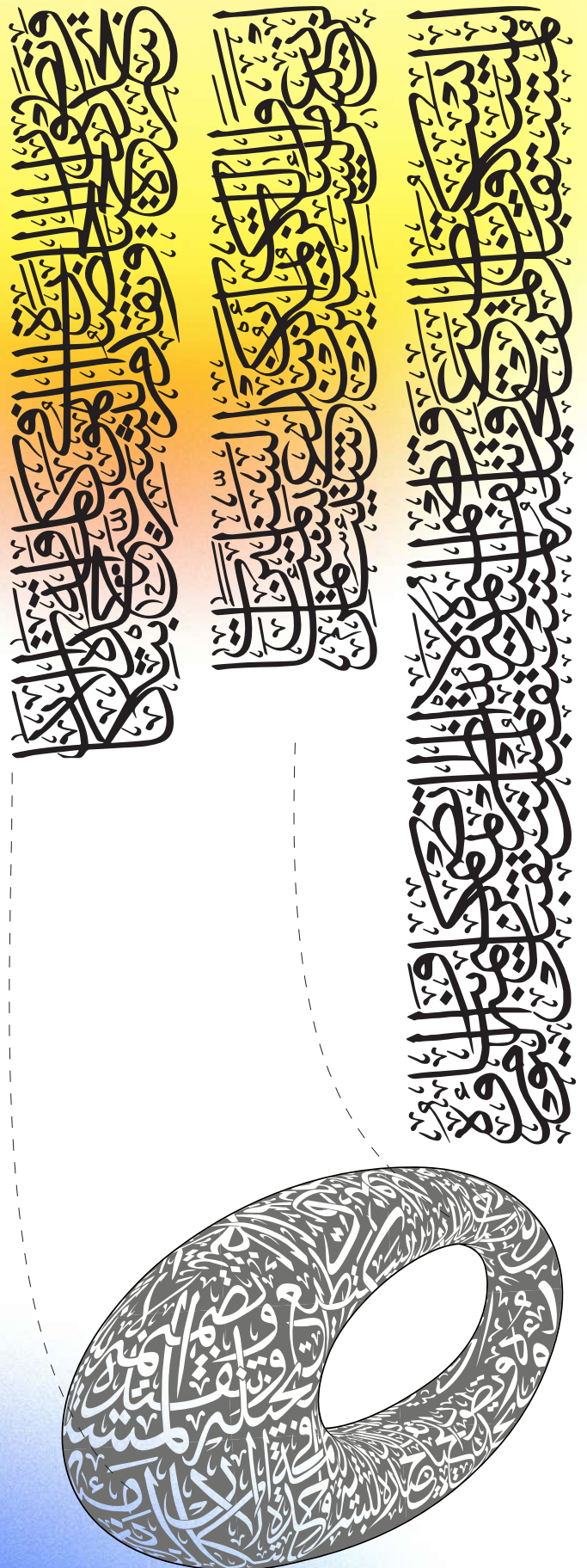
Artistic:

- The Museum of the Future is the most beautiful building on earth. With symbolic, artistic and philosophical connotations, it is a great inspirational and artistic icon.
- The external design of the museum forms a human eye, representing the knowledge we bare witness today and refers to the future vision. The museum is the eye that sees tomorrow. The void in the heart of the structure represents the unknown that we seek to discover, as it is the future that we will reach.
- The green plateau, that holds the Museum of the Future, represents stability and the strength of the inspiring Emirati experience. The future is of no value if it does not start from history.
- The Arabic calligraphy on the facade of the museum is of significant artistic value. It is distinguished by its exceptional beauty through its letters, which makes it the most aesthetically rich and adaptable among the languages of the world.
- The Arabic calligraphy represents the philosophical vision of this edifice of knowledge, which comes in line with three inspirational quotes by H.H. Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum:

“We may not live for hundreds of years, but the products of our creativity can leave a legacy long after we are gone.”

“The future belongs to those who can imagine it, design it, and execute it. It isn't something you await, but rather create.”

“Innovation is not an intellectual luxury. It is the secret behind the evolution and rejuvenation of nations and people.”



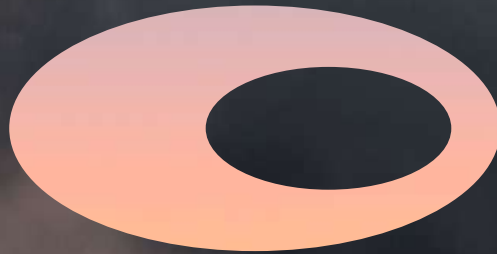
5. What experiences will the Museum of the Future offer to its visitors?
