

## Vietnam Visa Exemption

As of August 2022, regular passport holders from **24 COUNTRIES** below **DO NOT** need a tourist visa for Vietnam:

Countries	Passport Required	MAXIMUM STAY
<a href="#">Finland</a>	Yes	less than 15 days
<a href="#">France</a>	Yes	less than 15 days
<a href="#">Germany</a>	Yes	less than 15 days
<a href="#">Italy</a>	Yes	less than 15 days
<a href="#">Japan</a>	Yes	less than 15 days
<a href="#">Norway</a>	Yes	less than 15 days
<a href="#">Russia</a>	Yes	less than 15 days
<a href="#">South Korea</a>	Yes	less than 15 days
<a href="#">Spain</a>	Yes	less than 15 days
<a href="#">Sweden</a>	Yes	less than 15 days
<a href="#">United Kingdom</a>	Yes	less than 15 days

- British National Overseas (BNO) passport holders are not eligible for the 15-day free visa exemption. Hence, BNO passport holders are required to obtain a valid visa to visit Vietnam.
