
## 1415-1430: Lunch at local favourite restaurant Manam










### 0400-1200: Gear up for an early morning hike up Mt. Taal



After your meal, head to Paradizoo - home to sprawling flower gardens and unique farm animals like llamas, camels and ostriches!






## 0900-1230: Immerse yourself in art at Pinto Art Museum

# 1000-1300: Visit the National Museum of the Philippines


