

1530-1730: Bring out your inner chef with a Cantonese cooking class!

Getting there:

Walk for 7 min from Tsim Sha Tsui MTR Exit D2 (via Nathan Rd)

Getting there: We're sure that there are several convenience stores near your accommodation!



0830-1000: Grab some snacks at the nearest convenience store to go!

Getting there: The best way to get to Hong Kong Disneyland is via private vehicle, so make sure to book your <u>attraction transfers</u> beforehand! From Central Hong Kong, it'll take around 30 minutes to arrive at Lantau Island.

0830-0830: Hop on the MTR to Sheung Wan

One great thing about Hong Kong is its efficient transportation system! You can easily arrive from point a to point b in a matter of minutes without being hassled by complex train lines. That said, you should take advantage of this and explore Hong Kong's more popular districts such as Sheung Wan! Although it's considered Hong Kong's main business district, the area is dotted with amazing restaurants and endless shopping!

Getting there:

Arrive at Sheung Wan by taking the MTR to Sheung Wan Station and take Exit D.





0830-0945: Munch on some dim sum for breakfast at Lin Heung Kui

It's time for the most important meal of the day - breakfast! Open as early as 6:00am, you'll be able to feast on some of Hong Kong's most exquisite Chinese delicacies! Popping in Lin Heung Kui for a delicious Michelin-awarded meal is the best way to start your day, so go ahead and indulge in shrimp dumplings, lotus seed buns and bean curds!

Getting there:

From Sheung Wan Station Exit A2 and walk towards Cleverly Street. You will arrive at Lin Heung Kui in roughly 15 minutes!

Hop off the TramOramic and make your way to <u>Tai Cheong Bakery</u> to get a taste of Hong Kong's famous egg tarts! 1030-1230: Enjoy Hong Kong's historic landmarks from the TramOramic Hong Kong Tour!


After a satisfying meal, head on over to the Western Market Terminus to embark on a historical journey through Hong Kong on the 1920s styled <u>TramOramic tram</u>. If you've already seen a good chunk of Hong Kong by this time, you would have probably seen this tram roaming the streets of Hong Kong with its "ding ding" bells.

The great thing about this tour is that you get unlimited rides throughout the day and the next day if you still happen to be in the area. We also recommend taking a seat in the upper deck for the full experience!











1130-1400: Explore and have lunch at Causeway Bay

Walk off some of those egg tarts and head over to the city's retail capital - Causeway Bay! If you've got cash to burn, get them ready, because you're about to take part in a shopping experience like no other! But apart from the store-lined streets, Causeway Bay is also home to upscale restaurants, food stalls, and landmarks such as the Hong Kong Central Library and Victoria Park.

Venture out into the hidden alleyways of Causeway Bay and locate **San Ka La**, a local brewery specializing in innovative cuisine. Since you've already gotten a taste of authentic Cantonese dishes, why not explore more of Hong Kong's culinary scene?

Hop on the MTR and make your way to Mong Kok, the busiest shopping area in the city! Hong Kong is basically one big shopping market, so you won't be running out of places to shop for sure! Everything here is discounted, so you don't necessarily have to spend a fortune to get a hold of some trendy pieces! To narrow down your shopping expedition, check out Ladies' Market, Sneaker Street and Temple Street Night Market!







2000-2130: Dinner at Hee Wan Roasted Kitchen

There are pubs and bars fit for every person, so don't be afraid to explore! We recommend Rummin Tings, Lily and Bloom, The Woods and Ping Pong to start off your night.

Getting there: Walk 4 minutes to the Mong Kok Station to the Mong Kok Station and ride the Tsuen Wan Line (Red Line) for around 26 minutes to Central Station! Walk about 6 minutes to Lan Kwai Fong.

1000 - 1330: Discover Ocean Park Hong Kong!

Now that you're stomachs are full, it's time to start today's adventure! Meet up with your driver in Sheung Wan for your attraction transfer to Ocean Park Hong Kong. With this hassle-free transportation option, you don't have to worry about getting lost or arriving late. The best time to enter Ocean Park is right when it opens at 10am to get the most out of your visit while tourists bulk up at around lunch time.

This zoo-theme park crossover is truly one of a kind! Not only will you get up close and personal with marine life in one of the world's largest aquariums, but you would also be riding on some of the most thrilling roller coasters in the country! Make you don't miss out on the Hair-Raiser, the Dragon, and Raging River to name a few.

Getting there:

Meet up with your attraction transfer driver and make the drive down to Ocean Park for around 30 minutes!



0830-0930: Enjoy a traditional Hong Kong breakfast at Congteakafe!

Do as the locals do and indulge in a traditional Hong Kong breakfast - scrambled eggs and toast! This simple but delicious meal is favored by many locals since it's the type of comfort food that's perfect to start the day! However, if scrambled eggs with toast isn't exactly your cup of tea, Congteakafe also serves burgers, eggs benedict or chicken wings to match any type of craving.

We highly recommend dining al fresco so you can observe the locals as they start their day whilst sipping on a cup of joe!

DAY 4 | Ocean Park & Hong Kong Island









1400-1900: Join in on a tour to see the Best of Hong Kong Island

After a fun-filled morning in Ocean Park, why not discover the best sights and attractions in Hong Kong Island in a join-in tour? Although Hong Kong Island isn't as popular as the cities of Kowloon and Tsim Sha Tsui, you'll be surprised to know that this island is filled with cultural landmarks and a whole lot of shopping!
