### 1. Drive from the Gold Coast to Brisbane

Your next stop: Brisbane! This riverside city is only about an hour's drive out from the Gold Coast. With an up-and-coming arts scene, modern architecture by the water, international dining spots and pockets of nature, Brisbane is a stop to make on your Queensland road trip.





#### 2. Skydive Brisbane

Push your boundaries with a tandem jump at **Skydive Brisbane.** Tandem jumps are perfect for first timers as you are attached to an instructor via harness! The skydive instructors take on an average of 8 to 10 jumps daily, with some doing this for over 50 years!

# 3. Have lunch at Brisbane's farmers market

#### **3. Visit the Irwin legacy - Australia** Zoo

We all remember watching Steve Irwin on TV as a kid, seeing him captivate the audience with his daring interactions with some of the most ferocious animals on earth. His passion and love for wildlife could be felt even from the screens, and it's heartening to witness how his legacy continues to live on at the **Australia Zoo.** 

The Australia Zoo, approximately the size of 76 football fields, is the biggest zoo in Australia. It is home to the best wildlife conservation facilities in the entire world! <u>Skip-the-queues when you pre-purchase your Australia Zoo ticket on Klook</u>!

#### 5. Fraser Island Day Trip

On this <u>full day ranger guided tour</u>, discover Fraser Island's iconic natural attractions, also known as the "Beauty Spots". Start off with a visit to Lake McKenzie where you can take a dip in the crystal clear waters or relax on the sandy white beaches, before heading to Central Station and the Wanggoobla Creek, where you'll find yourself surrounded by all types of flora.

There's much more included in this tour and we won't spoil too much - but it does include a drive along the famous 75 Mile Beach where you might spot some humpback whales!

#### 1. See different marine critters up-close at the Cairns Aquarium

Discover Australia's incredibly diverse marine life at Cairns Aquarium, located in the heart of the city not far from the Lagoon. The <u>Cairns</u> <u>Aquarium</u> houses over 15,000 marine and land animals from two World Heritage listed areas - the Great Barrier Reef and the Wet Tropics Rainforest. up close and in any weather conditions.

You are guaranteed to learn plenty of interesting facts about the underwater world. Consider this the teaser to your big Great Barrier Reef adventure the next day!

#### 2. Lunch at Caffiend

One of Cairns's hottest cafes, **Caffiend** is just the place for brunch in the city. With excellent coffee, colorful brunch plates and generous portions, you'll definitely be refuelled for the rest of your day's activities! Their chilli jam is delicious.

#### **3. Fly above Australia's World** Heritage listed Tropical Rainforest on the Rainforest Skyrail Cableway

A must-experience Cairns attraction, the <u>Skyrail</u> <u>Cableway</u> provides a truly unique perspective of Australia's World Heritage listed tropical rainforest. Glide just metres above the pristine rainforest canopy, before descending to explore the forest floor at the Red Peak and Barron Falls.

The Skyrail experience is 7.5 kilometres long and will take approximately 1.5 hours each way, including time spent at two rainforest stations. Ensure you get the most out of your experience by downloading Skyrail's multilingual Interpretive App and Audio Guide that places the story of Queensland's ancient tropical rainforest directly in your hands.
