Upon arrival: Pick up your 4G SIM card

You'll definitely need a <u>4G SIM Card</u> this trip because it will surely be filled with picture perfect moments all around.

1100-1200: Have lunch at Khao Soi Maesai

Khao Soi is one of the most popular dishes in Chiang Mai. This coconut curry based noodle is a Northern Thai dish and one of the best places to have it in Chiang Mai is at **Khao Soi Maesai.**

This no frills open air dining establishment is brimming with locals and at only THB 40 a bowl, you'll surely be back for more!

1445-1515: Visit the Wat Phra Doi Suthep

From the peak of the Doi Suthep Pagoda, you can enjoy a panoramic view of the surroundings and marvel at the splendor of it all.

DAY 2 | Elephant Jungle Sanctuary











1030-1530: Spend a full day with the elephants!

One of the most unique experiences you'll have in Chiang Mai is getting to play with the elephants! Forget unethical camps where elephants are forced to put on performances for you. Instead, spend a day with these rehabilitated elephants at the <u>Elephant Jungle Sanctuary!</u>

Start off by getting to know the elephants and the best way to do this is with treats! Say "bon bon" which means up and watch them raise their trunks. You can then proceed to place a sugar cane on their trunks or into their mouths!

Afterwhich, you'll have lunch (provided) as well as make some treats for them by mashing rice and bananas. They will then line up for their health check where you'll get to inspect their bodies for bites and scratches.

You'll also be given brushes and hoses to scrub them clean. Head in to the mud after that and grab a handful to rub on their bodies!

Finally, wash off the mud and splash buckets of water on these gentle giants in the river. It truly takes a village to raise an elephant.

1930-2000: Dessert at Graph Cafe

DAY 3 | Chiang Rai



O915-1930: Go on the White Temple, Blue Temple and Black House Chiang Rai Tour

Chiang Rai is located 3 hours away from Chiang Mai and serves as a good day trip from the city. Home to famous temples like the White Temple, Blue Temple and the Black House, sign up for the Klook tour and get taken to all 3 in a day from Chiang Mai.

The **White Temple** is probably the most famous of them, with insanely intricate details but with a modern twist. You'll find motifs of modern day icons like the Minions and the Avengers around the temple!

The **Blue Temple**, also known as the House of Dancing Tigers draws huge crowds daily for the beautiful carvings and the giant white Buddha in the main hall.

Lastly, the eerie yet serene **Black House** blends traditional Thai architecture with art displays. Home to creator Duchenne's extensive collection of weird taxidermy and bones, this might make you feel slightly uneasy.

1945-2100: Dinner at Tong Tem Toh

Tong Tem Toh is a restaurant that specializes in Northern Thai cuisine or Lanna cuisine. Set in a modern setting with dark wooden benches and tables and even mist machines to keep you cool, here are some dishes you should try!

Try the Thai Nam Prik - a chilli sauce made from roasted banana peppers that you can eat with an array of boiled vegetables.

The Kaeng Hang Lay is a pork curry stew that pairs perfectly with a bowl of steamed rice.



2100-2200: Dessert at Mango Tango

No visit to Thailand is complete without a round of mango desserts! Apart from the usual mango sticky rice, **Mango Tango** serves up a huge variety of other mango dishes.

Our top pick is the Mango pudding with fresh mango and the mango smoothies!

DAY 4 | Doi Inthanon Tour









1000-1700: Doi Inthanon National Park Day Tour

The <u>Doi Inthanon Mountains</u> are the highest peaks in Thailand and a must visit in Chiang Mai. The best way to explore the <u>national park</u> is to let the <u>driver and guide take you around!</u>

Start off with a walk on the **Angkha trail** and take in the beautiful mountain air. It can be pretty chilly up there so be sure to pack a light jacket!

Afterwhich, head to the **Royal Twin Pagodas** where you can stroll through the beautiful Queen pagoda gardens!

P.S. There are escalators up!

Head to the **Vachiratharn Waterfall** next and experience the gush of the majestic falls. We wouldn't recommend heading all the way down because it can be pretty slippery!

Lastly, the **Royal Agricultural project** is the place to pick up last minute souvenirs! You'll find plenty of local organic produce.

You can then request for the driver to drop you off at the airport for your flight back home!
